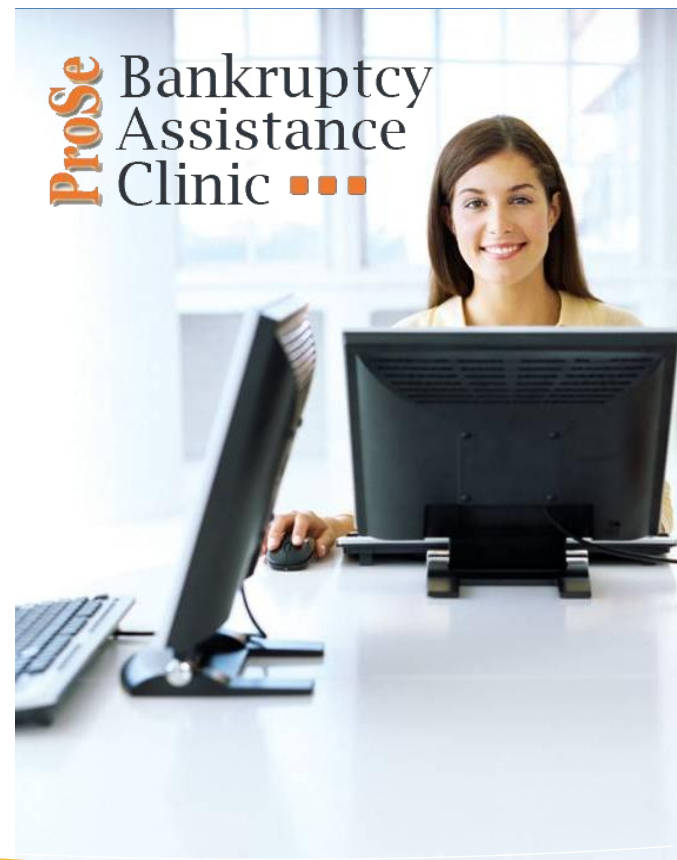

volunteers and offers free, on-site information and
guidance to individuals who are representing themselves
in the U.S. Bankruptcy Court. The lawyer volunteers at
the Clinic can help the pro se litigant understand the
bankruptcy process and provide limited case-specific
advice, but they cannot represent the litigant in court or
file pleadings.

How can we help you?

BE PREPARED. BEFORE YOUR APPOINTMENT PLEASE...

- WRITE A LIST OF SPECIFIC QUESTIONS FOR THE ATTORNEY
- BRING THE MOST RECENT COURT PAPERS THAT WERE SERVED ON YOU OR THAT YOU FILED WITH THE COURT
- BRING ALL DOCUMENTS, CONTRACTS & PAPERWORK RELATED TO YOUR CASE, INCLUDING YOUR BANKRUPTCY SCHEDULES OF ASSETS AND LIABILITIES
- IDENTIFY ANY DEADLINES AND TELL US ABOUT THEM FIRST
- DO RESEARCH AND KNOW THE FACTS OF YOUR CASE BEFORE YOUR APPOINTMENT

WHEN CAN I GET HELP AT THE CLINIC?

The Clinic is open on Tuesdays and Wednesdays from 9am - Noon.

DO I NEED TO HAVE AN APPOINTMENT?

Generally, the Clinic is first come, first served with priority given to those persons who have requested an appointment in advance or to those on a deadline. You can schedule an appointment on our website or by calling (407) 476-4331.

WHAT CAN I EXPECT WHEN I ARRIVE AT THE CLINIC?

You will need to complete an Intake Form and Liability Waiver before you can be seen by an attorney. Intake Forms and Liability Waivers are available at the Clinic or can be downloaded from our website.

HOW LONG IS MY CONSULTATION?

The Clinic provides the pro se debtor or creditor the opportunity to meet, one-on-one, with a volunteer bankruptcy attorney for a free half-hour consultation.

WHAT DO I DO IF I'M ON A DEADLINE?

If you have an important deadline upcoming soon, please contact the Clinic staff immediately to set up an appointment by calling (407) 476-4331 or by sending an email to bankruptcy400@gmail.com. The Clinic does give priority whenever possible to those who are on a deadline.
